





The impact of this contribution on families in our community is immeasurable. We are excited to announce that 100% of this donation will go directly towards helping families and children remain in their homes, thereby preventing the need for shelter. We are truly grateful to everyone who contributed to this initiative.

**Family Mentoring Pilot Program**: I am pleased to share that Family Promise of Tulsa County (FPTC) has partnered with Southminster Presbyterian Church to launch a pilot program titled "Just Neighbors." This program aims to provide comprehensive support to one family, focusing on mentorship throughout their journey with FPTC, in addition to case management. We anticipate launching soon and look forward to gathering valuable feedback, which we will share with our congregations to assess interest in expanding this opportunity and supporting additional families in our shelter program.

# Apartment Shelter Program Update:

Since our last update, every family in our program has successfully graduated and transitioned into their own homes. As of today, we are currently supporting six families, which include four single mothers, one two-parent family, and one single father, collectively caring for 11 children. All families are thriving; some have secured employment and are actively participating in our family savings program, while others are beginning their journey towards stable work and income. Each family is unique and valuable, and we remain committed to ensuring their success not only today but in the future as well.

### A Future Begins at Home Update:

As previously mentioned, FPTC is now receiving \$12,500 per month through July, with the expectation of an extension through December pending confirmation of a potential grant. This increase in funding allows us to nearly double the number of families we can assist each month, which is truly a blessing.


Since January, FPTC has provided financial assistance to 36 families, successfully keeping 78 children in their homes and preventing the trauma of homelessness. This number is expected to grow, as we are still processing our March applications and will be able to support several additional families before our March 2025 funding is fully allocated.

Most encouragingly, we continue to achieve an exceptional success rate in our prevention and diversion program, maintaining 98% of the families we serve in their homes. This is certainly something to celebrate.
