We welcomed a new mom and her two precious little boys into our program last week. She is so excited and grateful for the opportunity to have her own apartment with her children as she works to rebuild

her life. She was thrilled when she opened the door to her new apartment and was instantly relieved when she knew her family was going to be OK. Our two parent family that was raising their grandson has been approved and is move into a duplex over the weekend.
