UPDATES FROM TINA



What an incredibly busy summer we have had at FPTC. Between our newly expanded shelter program and our amazingly successful prevention/diversion program, we have been burning the midnight oil, keeping families and children in their own homes and pulling families out of homelessness into safety and security. As always, we cannot do what we do without the amazing support of our generous donors, amazing volunteers, and fantastic community partners. Together we are changing lives.

Apartment Shelter Program Update:

As of two weeks ago, FPTC added two additional units to our apartment shelter program so we can now provide support to eight families at time. Four units can house single mothers with their children and four units can house single fathers with children and or two parent families. We still need additional space as the need continues to grow, however, we are blessed have the two additional units. As of today, August 14, 2025, FPTC has 121 families on our waiting list and the numbers continue to increase daily. We may not be able to help every family right now, however, we are blessed to help the ones we can.

We are thrilled to share an inspiring success story about a remarkable single father and his four children. In just over 90 days in our program, this dedicated dad has made incredible strides. He has secured a well-paying job, saved a significant amount of money, and is set to move into his own home on September 1st!

Thanks to the support of FPTC, his deposit is paid, and the utility deposits for lights and water are taken care of. Because of this journey, he and his children are almost HOME. This story is a beautiful testament to resilience, hope, and the power of community. We couldn't be happier for this family as they embark on this new chapter together!

A Future Begins at Home (Prevention/Diversion)Update:

Our prevention/diversion program is doing amazing thing and keeping families in their own homes. We are so grateful to everyone who has contributed financially to support this worthwhile mission of keeping families in their homes. The more funds available for this life saving program, the more families we can keep in their homes and prevent potential childhood trauma for our littlest neighbors in need.

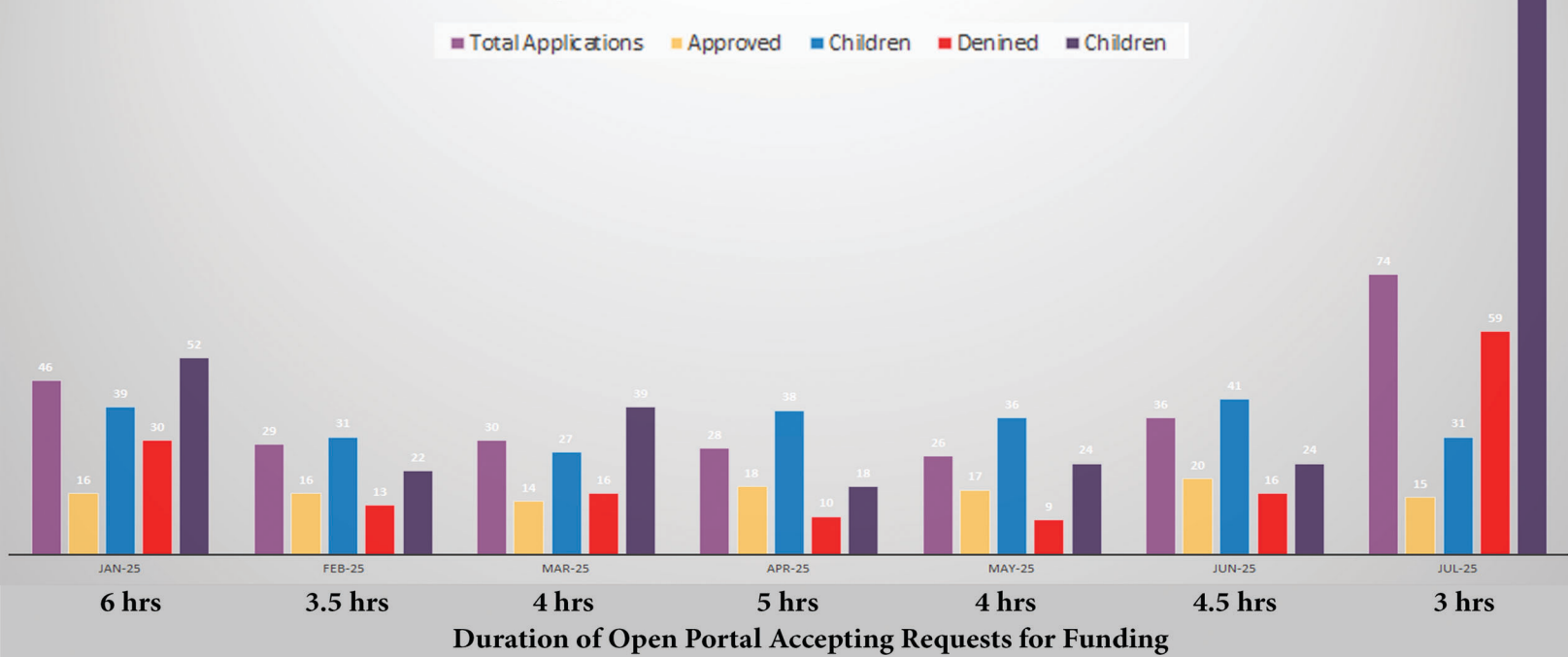

Since January 1, 2025, FPTC has assisted 143 families, safeguarding 296 children in their homes and preventing potential childhood trauma associated with homelessness, achieving a commendable 95% success rate. We are still working through applications so this number will increase slightly, however, this is definitely something to celebrate. We have witnessed the profound impact of our work through numerous families: from a single mother who missed a week of work due to her child's illness, to a father faced with car repairs that jeopardized his rent, to a grandmother unexpectedly raising three grandchildren who needed school supplies and is now grateful for restored utility services. These are just a few examples of the countless families we have supported thanks to your generosity. We sincerely appreciate your partnership in this vital mission. Together, we ending homelessness...one family at a time.
