What's Happening at FPTC...Family Updates

We currently have 3 families in our apartment shelter program and each and every one of them are doing amazing. We have three openings at this time and are scheduling interviews with families seeing support. One mom in particular has completed tasks that she did not think was possible. During her time here, she has secured a good job and is saving money for her future.

When families graduate our program we ask them to complete an exit survey about their time here and what if anything we could improve for the next family. This particular family had fallen on hard times and had a significant eviction to pay off before she could secure a new home for herself and her children. When asked how we could improve the mom stated, "they don't need to improve anything. I am so thankful for them. They have done so much." When asked if she would recommend FPTC the mom stated, "They actually help. Go there now. They will definitely help you get back on your feet. I have money, a good job, and a place to call my own." ~FPTC Graduate

Our new prevention/diversion program has actually kept a few families in their home and they no longer need the shelter. This is amazing. I am so grateful that we have the opportunity to keep families in their homes and am grateful for everyone who donated to make this opportunity possible.

Shannon has agreed to stay on part time for as long as she can after she starts her new position on May 13th or until we have someone amazing trained and ready to go.
