### A Heavy Heart in for our Community

On Thursday, April 3rd, FPTC received over 32 calls from families in desperate need of shelter. These are single mother who cannot be with their children because they are living on the street, or the two parent family with a young child who is forced to sleep in their car for over two weeks now with nowhere to go.

Each call weighs heavily on our hearts as we face

the unfortunate reality: every shelter in Tulsa is at capacity, and we have no available units to offer. In these challenging times, we must ask ourselves: how do we offer hope? While our resources are stretched thin, we can still extend compassion and support. We can connect families with community resources, provide emotional support, and advocate for more housing solutions.

Together, let's work towards a future where every family has a safe place to call home.

# Apartment Shelter Program Update:

As of today, we are currently supporting six families, which include four single mothers, one two-parent family, and one single father, collectively caring for 11 children. All families are thriving; some all have secured employment and are actively participating in our family savings program, One of our single mothers iare graduating the program and moving into her new home this weekend. We will get the unit cleaned and ready to welcome the new family quickly.

# A Future Begins at Home Update:

Since January, FPTC has provided financial assistance to 44 families, successfully keeping 97 children in their homes and preventing the trauma of homelessness. I am thrilled to report the program has a 100% success rate through March 31, 2025. Thank you to everyone who contributed and contributes to this life changing program.

Our prevention and diversion program, A Future Begins at Home, serves as a vital lifeline for families facing crisis.


