# UPDATES FROM TINA



This year, we have witnessed a staggering increase in the demand the services FPTC provides and as the days and nights grow colder parents are desperate for a glimmer of hope and a place to call home. Today there are over 2,400 students in Tulsa Public Schools and 787 in the Broken Arrow school district that are receiving services for housing insecurity and or experiencing literal homelessness. Many of these children's lives are filled with uncertainty and fear, lacking the basic necessities we often take for granted: a warm bed, nutritious meals, and a safe place to call home.

As we approach the end of 2024, I find myself reflecting on the challenges and triumphs we've experienced together. It's a time for gratitude, and I want to personally thank you for your continued support of Family Promise of Tulsa County. Your generosity has made a significant impact in the lives of many children and families in our community.

We have a total of six families in the program. They are all doing well and are beyond blessed this holiday season. The families are safe and secure in a warm and safe home and will wake up Christmas morning knowing they are loved, appreciated, and cared for as they work toward a better tomorrow for themselves and their children. I would like to give a special shout out to our friends at Kirk of the Hills for providing an amazing Christmas morning for the children and parents in our shelter program.

## A Future Begins at Home Update:

In the last 11 months FPTC has provided \$53,620 in financial support to families in our community. We have helped 82 families, kept 171 children in their own homes and prevented the trauma of homelessness. We continue to have an amazing success rate for prevention/diversion funding and have kept 98% of every family we have served in their homes.


